

Wait for the Gate!



Beginning June 17, trains will operate through the Burlingame station on both tracks at the same time.

Not all trains stop at the station, and those that bypass the station don't slow down. A train may stop for passengers on one platform while another train passes through the station on the other track. To prevent passengers from crossing when it's not safe to do so, Caltrain has installed a fence between the tracks and pedestrian crossing arms, bells and lights.

Observe these important safety rules:

- Cross tracks **ONLY** at designated crossings and only when it's safe to do so.
- Watch for a second train.
- Never go around a lowered crossing gate.
- Trains can operate on either track at any time.

If a train passes in one direction, do not assume it is safe to cross. Another train may be coming on the other track.
